Welcome to the **BAMPI Production Room!** This will guide you through the process of using the studio for recording and mixing. Before you start using the studio, it's essential to familiarise yourself with the equipment. Here's a little overview:

- Computer and DAW: An Apple MacMini running Logic Pro and Ableton Live as primary software for recording, editing and mixing.
- Audio Interface: The audio interface is a <u>Focusrite Red 8Pre</u> connecting your instruments and microphones to the computer for recording and playback.



 Monitor Speakers: The Focusrite above outputs to a pair of Genelec 8030c speakers that are used for playback.



 Rack Tie Lines: These are where you plug your microphone cables in for monitoring and recording. They correlate to Mic 1-8 inputs and Line 1-8 inputs of the Red8Pre interface and in your DAW



 Headphone Amp: The SubZero headphone amp offers additional headphone mixes if needed.



 Monitor Controller: This is intended to control the output level of the speakers and to connect any external device via the mini Jack cable provided.

Instructions

- 1. Turn the MacMini and the Red8 Pre ON, then the speakers.
- 2. Please use the **Student** account to sign in.
- 3. When you fire up **Logic** for the first time, a new project will be created using the default **304 Template** specifically made for this room, with 16 channels available that correlate to Mic 1-8 inputs and Line 9-16 inputs of the Rack Tie Lines

NB: you can also use this template for monitoring the **Yamaha CP88** stage piano through the Genelecs (input channels **15/16**)

4. Please make sure to rename your Logic project, save it and collect all your files on your hard drive at the end of you session.
